#### **Interleaving for revision**

Interleaving is when you switch between different topics in your revision sessions. Switching between topics helps your brain to see the similarities and differences between them. It helps to avoid confusion and also allows you to make links between different areas of study, which aids retention. Finally, it's much harder than studying just one topic for a long time, and this difficulty means your brain has to work harder, which means it remembers more.
